Note 1. Data Security Policy

In accordance with the General Protection of Data Regulation (2018) we shall not reveal your details outside of the membership or cause it to be used for any Commercial purpose with the following exception, if applicable. When you join Surrey Walking Club or renew your membership you can choose to be registered as a member of England Athletics (EA). For convenience the table shown in note 2 groups our membership into a number of categories and membership of EA applies to all except classes 7 and 10. These classes of members, which include most Strollers, may ignore the following section. (You will have to register with EA if you have not already done so and ever compete for the Club under the United Kingdom Athletics (UKA) rulebook). If you tick the box 4 above we will provide EA with your personal data which they will use to enable access to an online portal for you (called myAthletics). EA will contact you to invite you to sign into and update your myAthletics portal (which among other things, allows you to set and amend your privacy settings). If you have any questions about the continuing privacy of your personal data when it is shared with EA, please contact dataprotection@englandathletics.org. If you do not tick box 4, and then decide to compete for the club, we will need to register you with EA and will inform you at that time.

Note 2. England Athletics Grouping

Under the current rules for athletics in England some members, particularly those wishing to compete for the Club as First Claim Walkers will be registered with England Athletics. As this is complicated with different rules for applicants the Club has set up a number of groups and all members will belong to one of these. If you do not know which group applies to you then contact the Hon.Secretary or any Club officer. A payment(currently £16 per annum for 2022/23) must be paid in the case of groups 1 and 8 only. Most Strolling members will fall into group 10 and the scheme will not affect them and they will not be registered with EA.

6	Racing Official/Officer/Coach Registered
7	Racing Inactive Unregistered
8	Stroller and occasional Active Athlete

11	Non-member (only used on file for past members)

All members wishing to take part in races, particularly County, Southern and National Championships, must be registered and, in the case of first Claim walkers, pay an additional EA supplement, currently £15, which will be paid to EA by the Club on the member's behalf. In order to do this the member will pay the Club, initially with this application form and in future with their annual subscription, the amount due to EA in advance.

All members, apart from groups 7 and 10, accept that the minimum information (name, address, Email address, telephone numbers and date of birth) will be registered with EA. For groups 1, 3 and 8 the applicant also is agreeing to pay the EA supplement (currently £15). For Groups 4 and 5 the applicant will not need not pay Surrey Walking Club the additional amount but must declare that their EA supplement has been or will be paid by their first claim club.

Note 3.

All applicants are expected to have attended a Club event prior to election.
